4. Paul Belcher's 20.9 yards per pass for the season is the highest average from 1969 to 1979.
5. Brad Koenig's 7.3 yards per rush for the season is the highest average from 1969 to 1979.
6. Bill Pearson's 28.8 yards per play for season is the highest average from 1969 to 1979.
7. Paul Belcher's 60-yard TD pass play to Jeff Liter against Canton was the longest TD passing and receiving from 1969 to 1979.
8. Brad Koenig's 40-yard run without scoring a TD is the longest from 1969 to 1979.
9. The Team's 65 rushes against U High was the highest from 1969 to 1979.
10. The Team's 8 TD's against Clinton tied the 1975 Team for most TD's scored in a game from 1969 to 1979.
